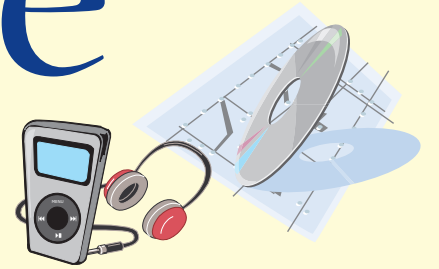

Dream Big – Read! Summer Reading Club

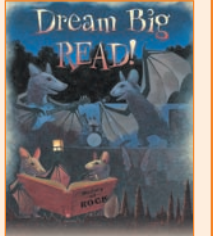


Birth – 35 months
