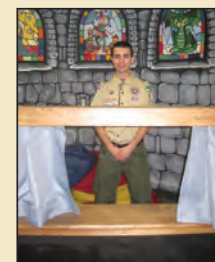
BOOK WARS COMPETITION HPJ1082
